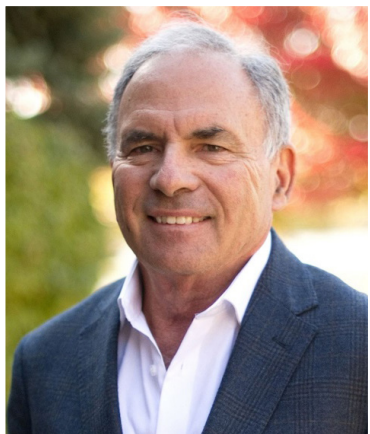


AAIM BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Dr. Charles Nozicka is a dual board certified physician (Pediatrics and Pediatric Emergency Medicine). He is the former Division Director for pediatric emergency medicine at Advocate Children's Hospital. He is a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics and a Clinical Professor of Emergency Medicine at the Chicago Medical School. He has authored medical book chapters and numerous academic papers.
